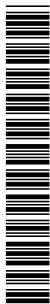

- (b) Discuss the impact of the War Guilt Clause (Article 231 of the Treaty of Versailles) on Germany. [25]

- (b) Discuss the importance of the Reichstag Fire. [25]

Depth study C: Russia, 1905–41

- 5 (a) Write an account of the social and economic problems facing Russia's industrial workers between 1905 and 1914. [15]
