- (b) Discuss the importance of Stresemann's appointment as Chancellor in 1923. [25]
- 4 (a) Write an account of developments on the German Home Front during the Second World War. [15]
- (b) Discuss the impact of the Second World War on the Nazi treatment of the Jews. [25]

Depth study C: Russia, 1905–41

- 5 (a) Write an account of the problems facing Russia before the outbreak of the 1905 Revolution. [15]
- (b) Discuss the importance of the peasants in the 1905 Revolution. [25]
- 6 (a) Write an account of Stalin's rise to power by 1928. [15]
- (b) Discuss the impact of Stalin's emergence as leader of the Soviet Union. [25]

Depth study D: The United States, 1919–41
